MAKE MUSIC FOR ME pulled his way to the early lead leaving the chute, set the pace on the inside down the backstretch and into the lane, remained clear in the lane and drew away under urging. HAIMISH HY stalked the pace inside a rival around the first turn and down the backstretch, continued to battle that foe in the lane and won the place battle while no match for the winner. FIRE WITH FIRE stalked the pace outside a rival around the first turn and down the backstretch, continued outside that foe in the lane and lost the place late. JUNIPER PASS saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, came out for the stretch drive and did not make up the needed ground. BEER MEISTER saved some ground around the first turn, trailed down the backstretch, came out into the lane and did not pose a threat.
