Footnotes

GUTSHOT STRAIGHT saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn, was floated out a bit into the stretch while bidding alongside a rival, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away under urging in midstretch and won clear. TUMMEL pulled between horses then chased a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, rode the rail on the turn, came out in upper stretch and wore down the pacesetter late for the place. INNOCENT MAN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled briefly in upper stretch, drifted inward in the drive and was worn down by the runner-up late. LA MANO NERA stalked outside a rival or three deep, continued alongside a foe on the turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SIR ALLISON pulled early, stalked outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ROMAN GUITAR was in a good position stalking the pace a bit off the rail then between foes, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and gave way. GNARLY DUDE stumbled a step out of the gate and unseated the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling, GNARLY DUDE was the cause of his own trouble.
