Footnotes

SWEET SWAP bumped lightly at the start, was sent up to try to go inside in the chute then was in a bit tight, stalked just off the rail then inside on the turn, waited momentarily then got through along the fence in midstretch to gain the lead past the eighth pole and won clear under a moderate hand ride and a long hold late. CHILOQUIN had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, drifted out a bit from the whip when inching away in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. BOAT TRIP broke out a bit and bumped lightly with the winner, saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and just missed the place. COMPARI angled to the inside in the chute and stalked along the rail, came a bit off the fence on the turn, angled three deep into the stretch to loom a threat but lacked the needed kick in the final furlong. AL INSTANTE (CHI) had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the drive. SECOND CITY four wide early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
