Footnotes

WARREN'S GOLDIE bumped just after the start, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, split horses a quarter mile out, was three deep in midstretch, rallied to the front nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear under some urging. MY DIANE bumped and squeezed some at the start, chased just off the fence then inside on the turn, moved up some in midstretch, came out for room a sixteenth out and gained the place. RUNNING ISABELLA had speed inside then stalked along the fence, bid inside a rival into the turn, took the lead, inched away leaving the turn, got clear in the stretch, could not match the winner and was caught for second late. MAMA JANKA a half step slow to begin, stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed late response. BANANA SPLIT bumped and forced out some at the start, chased outside then three deep leaving the turn, came out then was fanned five wide into the stretch and did not rally. TOCOI MISS had speed outside a rival then inched away and lugged out on the backstretch, was angled in to duel outside that foe into the turn, lugged out again leaving the turn and into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
