CANDY FOR DEBBIE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. WOULD YOU three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. JOE CARL a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. GRAEME CRACKERJACK steadied between horses into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out some in the stretch, split foes past midstretch and was edged for third. BARON VON RED angled in and stalked just off the inside to the stretch and weakened. PAT'S PARADISE pulled his way along inside and was in tight off heels into the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn and weakened.
