Footnotes

REAL HEAT had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, kicked clear under left handed urging and held. VOLKONSKY between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out leaving the bend and again into the stretch, advanced under urging in midstretch, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out but continued willingly. BUFFALO HILLS went up inside to press the pace and was in a bit tight five eighths out, stalked inside on the backstretch and turn and edged a rival for third. HEAT FLASH unhurried a bit off the rail then inside, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. TRICKY JOURNEY had speed between foes to duel for the lead, battled inside on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. MR. FITZRAMATHORN between horses early, stalked three deep to the stretch and also weakened. STORM CAUTION was in a good position stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. PANAYIOTIS bobbed after the start, stalked inside then between horses leaving the backstretch and into the turn, steadied while dropping back between foes midway on the bend and gave way.
