### Footnotes

ITALIAN RULES had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away past midstretch, drifted out some in the final furlong but won clear under urging. INDIAN FIREWATER angled in and dueled outside the winner, battled alongside that one until midstretch, could not match strides thereafter but held second. LIVE SUNDAYS stalked the pace a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and again into the stretch and outfinished a rival for the show. RACING APTITUDE sent between horses early, stalked outside a rival then just off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SMART SPENDING broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. BENCH POINTS three deep early, chased off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the turn and weakened.
