FOLK DANCER had good early speed and lugged out early, dueled off the rail, angled in on the turn, inched clear past the eighth pole, drifted out in the final sixteenth despite right handed urging but held. LIL MISS MACKY four wide early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came out some in the stretch and went willingly to the wire to just miss. WOODMAN'S LASS hopped slightly at the start, settled inside, came out and went around a rival on the turn, angled back to the inside nearing the stretch and rallied along the fence in the drive. ROMAN CHARITY between foes early, chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was outfinished. MISS OOPS dueled outside the winner, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SOLDIER BETTY broke a bit slowly, settled outside then off the rail, angled in some and dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
