CLOSE TO THE EDGE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted out in the final sixteenth but held under some urging. LUCKARACK stalked a bit off the rail, went outside a rival three deep on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch, loomed behind the winner in the drive, angled inward in deep stretch and bested the rest. WARREN'S KNOCKOUT unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and just got the show. PALIO PRINCE chased off the rail then outside a rival leaving the turn and into the stretch and lost third late. SCOTFIELD BARRACKS broke inward and a bit slowly, was taken off the rail on the backstretch, continued off the fence on the turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. HOLLYWOOD HEIST sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled outside the winner then stalked on the turn, angled to the inside nearing the stretch and weakened.
