Footnotes

CHURCH AVENUE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the turn, fought back gamely under urging in the final furlong, drifted out a bit from the whip late but held on gamely. MS. G. I. JANE stalked the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but was outgamed. HAKUCHI (ARG) angled inward in the chute, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. FIFTH AVE (GB) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail chasing the pace, angled in on the turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and was edged for third. MONA STORM stalked off the rail on the backstretch and between foes on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. AFTER LATER prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked between horses leaving the turn and also weakened. BRAZILIAN CHARM a bit slow into stride, pulled her way between horses and took up in tight leaving the chute, settled just off the rail on the backstretch and turn and did not rally.
