AMARISH sent along outside a rival early, kicked clear and angled in on the turn and drew off in the final furlong under a tap of the whip on the shoulder and a moderate hand ride. MANEWAL had speed inside the winner then stalked that one on the turn, came out a bit leaving the turn, continued along the fence in the stretch and just held second. MORENO'S MINE wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival on the turn and in the stretch and held third between foes late. CINCO DE MARIO sent between horses early, angled in for the turn, came out past midstretch and just missed a minor award three wide on the line. MAJESTIC DESERT between foes early, chased off the rail then inside on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. STRETCH broke in and a bit awkwardly, steadied between foes soon after the start, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. TATES HUMOR saved ground chasing the pace, came under urging leaving the turn and weakened. EDDIE BETTER angled in while being sent between foes early, chased outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
