Footnotes

WILKINSON stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch, bid alongside LIBERIAN FREIGHTER to take the lead in midstretch, inched away under left handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely. MR. COMMONS angled in and chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn then angled to the inside into the stretch, came out in midstretch and finished well. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER angled in and dueled inside, kicked away and found the rail on the second turn, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but just lost second and saved third. COMPARI had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked leaving the second turn, came off the rail in the stretch and weakened. MOBILIZED three deep early, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, went around a foe leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. TIGAH (GB) steadied between foes early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CALIMONCO pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out some into the stretch and weakened. GREAT WARRIOR (BRZ) between foes early, saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside into the stretch and weakened. SOUL CANDY steadied in tight between foes early, settled outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep into the second turn, dropped back again and lacked a further response.
