Footnotes

HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS bobbled at the start, chased off the rail then outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead and won clear under left handed urging. WARREN'S RAIL BIRD dropped back and angled in on the backstretch, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and gained the place late. WARREN'S WESLEY had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch and bested the rest along the fence. CAPTAIN BEAU settled off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn and into the stretch and made a late run between foes in the stretch. ONE WORLD chased outside a rival or off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GREAT FRIENDS RULE bobbled at the start, had speed three deep to press the pace then stalked three wide or outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. ZIPPINGAROUNDTOWN sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace between horses, inched away into the turn, angled in leaving the bend, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. A THOUSAND ACES saved ground pressing the pace then stalked into the turn, dropped back on the turn and weakened. I. B. DREAMIN' settled off the pace inside and saved ground to no avail.
