Footnotes

AMP AND ADRENALIN pulled a bit between horses early, prompted the pace between foes to the stretch, took a short lead alongside the runner-up in midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. PATRIOTIC LION broke in and bumped a rival, had speed between foes then three deep, inched away briefly and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, fought back along the rail through the stretch but was outfinished late. PUBLIC DEFENDER stalked the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn, angled off the rail in midstretch and came back on late. BOB GRECO broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, swung out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and had a mild late bid. SWISS EMPEROR four wide early, stalked three deep then between

foes, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MILK MAN RAY came in some at the start, went five wide into the first turn, stalked four wide then bid three deep on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ANCIENT STONE six wide early, went four wide into the first turn then angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. MY DIVIDEND squeezed back at the break, settled outside a rival then off the rail, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. QUICK CENIZAS was bumped then bobbed sharply at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and failed to menace. BONNIE'S BEARCAT broke in some, went four wide into the first turn, prompted the pace three deep, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. LOUISTHEFIFTEENTH broke out a bit, stalked a bit off the rail then between foes midway on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, came out in the stretch and also weakened.
