Footnotes

ME LIKEY MIKEY dueled four deep in the early going then eased back, stalked outside the dueling leaders into the turn, angled over to save some ground around the turn, came out leaving the quarter pole to enter the stretch three wide, rallied three deep in midstretch, took a short lead leaving the sixteenth marker and was clear to the wire. CRESTATORRE chased inside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside through the final furlong and gained the place three deep on the wire. CHIBITA dueled for the lead three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, weakened in the final furlong and was caught for the place between horses on the wire. MAGIC CASTLE dueled on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, gradually weakened on the rail through the final furlong and was outfinished for a minor award. BLING CHA BLING chased the pace outside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, remained in the middle of the track for the stretch drive and did not offer the needed rally. MINISTER OF TRADE was unhurried down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and did not threaten in the drive. IN HIGH REGARDS dueled between horses on the backstretch, dropped back between foes into the turn and weakened through the lane.
