COMMA TO THE TOP sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, drifted out some in the stretch but held gamely under some urging while being flagged with the whip late. CENTRALINTELLIGENCE stalked a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and went on willingly but could not catch the winner. CAMP VICTORY a half step slow to begin, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and bested the rest. MAJESTIC CITY unhurried along the inside on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TIZ TEE TIME stalked just off the rail then outside a rival, continued between horses leaving the turn and weakened. APRIORITY was in a good position stalking the pace outside or off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
