Footnotes

MAMBO MAN stalked inside then between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, took a short lead outside the runner-up in midstretch and held under urging. CORINTHIAN'S SONG chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, bid alongside a foe on the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch, fought back off the rail in the final furlong but could not quite match the winner late. IRISH SURF four wide into the first turn, chased outside then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and finished with interest. KIN chased off the rail then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in some leaving the second turn and was outfinished. MIKEY T chased three deep on the first turn then off the rail, angled in off the fence on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. JUST FISHIN was in a good position chasing the pace three deep then outside on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CITRON KID saved ground chasing the pace, steadied in tight off heels into the second turn, came out on that turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HORIZONTALYSPEAKIN had

speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in into the backstretch, set the pace inside, fought back when challenged on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. SIR SEARSUCKER settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. ANZEAU chased between horses then dropped back inside on the backstretch, split rivals into the stretch and lacked a further response. GREAT RIDE was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival then off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch and weakened. ROCABAR sent between horses then angled in, pulled and lugged out into the first turn, angled in again and dueled then steadied off heels into the backstretch, stalked inside, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was pulled up in the stretch.
