Footnotes

PULPIT'S EXPRESS had speed between foes then kicked away and angled in, set the pace along the rail, opened up on the backstretch and remained clear in the lane under some left urging. FEAR THE BEARD also had early speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace throughout and edged a rival for the place. PASSING GAME three deep early, stalked outside the runner-up the rest of the way and was edged for second. MR. CANDY BAR pulled between horses and steadied into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TAMARACK SMARTY angled in and settled off the pace outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and went four wide on the line. ARRAIGNMENT three deep early, chased just off the rail or outside a rival, came out in the stretch and split foes on the wire. GOLD MEDALLION chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside into and on the second turn, went around a rival into the stretch and also went between horses on the line. WAR POLITICS chased three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LATE NIGHT SKY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. BUFFALO BILLY (IRE) broke a bit slowly, saved ground off

the pace to the stretch and failed to menace.
