CALLED TO SERVE chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter and put a head in front in midstretch, battled alongside that one through the final furlong and gamely prevailed under a tap of the whip and strong handling. PATRIOT'S VOYAGE sent between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged in the drive, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the end. BLU JON settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and a bit wide into the stretch and finished with interest to best the others. OLLISBLACKGOLD saved ground chasing the pace, moved up on the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response. MAKE US PROUD four wide into the first turn, stalked just off the rail, was between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. KILLER BEAR three deep nearing the first turn, chased outside a rival, dropped back and angled in on the second turn, came out in the stretch and also weakened.
