DANGEROUS DUO angled in and stalked a bit off the rail then inside, awaited room leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was in tight along the fence in midstretch, got through under urging past midstretch, gained a slim advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. CORINTHIAN'S SONG had good early speed and dueled inside, took a short lead nearing the second turn, inched away a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted out slightly past midstretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. TOMMY'S KID prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, re-bid three across the course past midstretch and also went on well to the end. MONEY TALKER a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. QATAR'S PEARL saved ground chasing the pace throughout but could not summon the necessary late kick. ET TU WALKER broke a bit slowly, angled in outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WHITE STAR LINE dueled between horses then outside a rival, dropped back between foes into the stretch and weakened. YOMYBATO tossed his head, broke in the air and behind the field and had the rider lose the irons and the right rein at the start, regained the irons past the wire the first time, saved ground to the stretch and trailed throughout. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling YOMYBATO was the cause of his own trouble.
