Footnotes

GONNA FLY NOW a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn and into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging along the fence to gain the lead nearing the wire. JIMMY CREED sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, came off the rail into the stretch, held well until deep stretch then could not contain the winner while outside that one late. CASTLETOWN stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. FRENCH STORM had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. CURRAHEE chased between horses then outside into and on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DEPUTY STRIKER bumped at the start, chased outside a rival, split horses nearing the turn, continued alongside a foe on the bend and lacked the needed rally. ANABAA PREMIUM chased three deep between foes, angled in alongside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and also lacked the necessary late kick. HEDGER broke a bit slowly, settled between horses then chased just off the rail, angled to the fence on the turn and did not rally. JULES JOURNEY broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail to the stretch and was not a threat. TIME LORD squeezed a bit at the start, settled outside or off the rail, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and was not a factor. REGULUS stalked five wide on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. SCOOTER'S STAR broke inward, dropped back outside then off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and was outrun, then was not persevered with late.
