Footnotes

BELLE ROYALE (IRE) angled in after the chute and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn, moved up into the stretch, came out in midstretch and rallied under some left handed urging to get up three wide late. QUIET OASIS (IRE) had speed between foes then dueled a bit off the rail or inside, battled between horses again leaving the backstretch then outside CAPITAL PLAN, drifted out from the whip in upper stretch, angled in and regained the advantage, fought back through the final furlong and was caught between foes late. CAPITAL PLAN had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail leaving the backstretch, dueled inside, fought back through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. CITY TO CITY angled in outside a rival after the chute then chased inside, came out into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. CAMBINA (IRE) broke slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. NEREID four wide in the run to the first turn, pressed or stalked the pace three and four wide then off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and weakened. WILD MIA prompted the pace between horses then three deep, continued outside the runner-up then between foes again on the backstretch, stalked off the rail on the second turn and also weakened. BAUBLE QUEEN chased inside then outside a rival on the first turn and backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
