Footnotes

BUSHIE had good early speed off the rail, angled in on the turn, dueled inside, inched away under urging a bit off the rail in deep stretch and held. BUSHWACKED bumped at the break, stalked three deep to the stretch and continued willingly late. SUMMER SEA close up stalking the pace along the inside throughout, also went on well to the end. TRIUNFO had speed outside foes then dueled alongside the winner, also angled in on the turn, fought back in midstretch and was outfinished late for a minor award. EXPONENTIALLY bumped at the start, had good early speed and stalked between horses, continued between foes through the drive and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. CHARLIE THOMAS broke inward and slowly, chased inside, came out in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. WESTERN SHOWDOWN a bit slow to begin, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. TIME TO BE A HERO stalked outside then four wide into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
