Footnotes

MAJOR MAGIC sped to the lead into the first turn, dueled on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch and proved best on the inside through the final furlong. TRUCIAL STATE chased the pace a bit off the rail down the backstretch, saved ground around the second turn, angled out in midstretch, could not catch the winner but was a clear second at the wire. TAKE NO PRISONERS was washy entering the gate, pulled hard between horses and steadied around the first turn, dueled outside the winner down the backstretch and around the second turn, could not keep pace at the top of the lane, weakened but held the show. TRAWEEK chased off the rail down the backstretch, steadied between horses entering the second turn, raced inside in the lane and lacked the necessary rally. LATE NIGHT SKY saved ground around the first turn, stalked off the rail down the backstretch, came out into the lane and did not rally. CHIBITA broke a bit slowly, was caught four wide around the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide and weakened.
