SASSY SUANCES broke out a bit, sped to the early lead and dueled inside, inched away into the turn, kicked clear, increased her advantage in the stretch to prove best under a steady hand ride while being shown the whip. TWELVE FOLDS stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out passing the quarter pole and three deep into the stretch and was second best. WARREN'S INTERNET steadied when crowded at the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail, angled back in for the turn, remained inside and bested the others. ROWDY GAL was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SWIMMIN INSUNSHINE pulled a bit and pressed the pace outside the winner, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, was between horses in midstretch and also weakened. GOTTA SKEDADDLE broke alertly then dropped back outside, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat.
