QUAIL HILL bumped between horses at the start, angled in and chased the leader inside, came out under urging in midstretch, overtook that rival past the sixteenth pole and won clear. EAST SKY sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in on the first turn and kicked clear, set the pace a bit off the rail while opening up on the backstretch, remained clear past midstretch, drifted inward and was overtaken inside the sixteenth pole but held second. WARRENS WILD THING hopped and was squeezed some at the start, angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and picked up the show. ALL DE VICTORS three deep into the first turn, settled outside a rival, went three wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. K JS MADDOG broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, saved ground to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. VICTORIASUGRDADDY saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SUPER CANDY allowed to settle outside a rival then inside on the backstretch and second turn and was not a threat. BEAU MAVERICK unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail to the stretch, went between foes past midstretch and did not rally. SOUTHERN SCULPTOR pulled his way along inside then chased just off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response.
