Footnotes

TIZ A MINISTER unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn, split horses three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch, angled in and rallied along the rail under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. DEN'S LEGACY between horses early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn, found the inside on that turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch, rallied three deep in late stretch, could not quite match the winner late but gained the place. MANANDO had speed and angled in outside a rival early, kicked away on the first turn, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was caught between horses in deep stretch. DICE FLAVOR broke out and a bit slowly, settled off the rail, went outside foes on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. JUST WIN BABY chased outside a rival, went up three deep then four wide leaving the backstretch, continued three wide on the second turn, angled in outside a foe leaving that turn and lacked the needed rally. BROADWAY EMPIRE pulled his way along with speed inside then came off the rail and pulled hard stalking the pace on the backstretch, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DIRTY SWAGG bobbled some in a bit of a slow start, angled in and chased the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. COUNTING DAYS chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival, continued between horses leaving the backstretch and alongside a foe on the second turn, was between horses nearing the stretch and had nothing left for the drive.
