Footnotes

RICHARD'S KID stalked a bit off the rail past the stands the first time around, took a short lead on the inside leaving the first turn, inched clear at the top of the lane and drew out under steady hand urging through the final furlong. DYNAMIC HOST was caught three wide into the first turn, angled to the inside around the turn, stalked inside a rival down the backstretch, moved closer on the rail into the second turn, came into the lane between horses and was a clear second at the wire. BALLADRY saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch, angled out under urging leaving the quarter pole, angled back towards the rail in the final furlong and gained the show late. HONOUR THE DEPUTY stalked the pace outside a rival down the backstretch, was caught three wide around the second turn and into the stretch, remained well off the rail through the lane and lost the show late. NORTHERN INDY pulled his way to the lead past the stands, showed the way around the first turn, stalked outside the winner down the backstretch, fell back between horses on the second turn and gave way in the lane.
