Footnotes

CONKATE forced the early issue outside leader, continued on two then three wide path into the stretch, grabbed command nearing eighth marker then came in some while powering away. BALENTINA tracked pace from the inside early, remained along the rail into the lane, found path inside rival in upper stretch, rallied bit then came off the fence late and proved second best. CHAPEL CHICK was bit slow to begin, stalked from the outside, continued three then four wide into the stretch and bested others. PUMPKIN PIE unhurried while slightly off the fence, shifted out three wide on the turn, caught four wide entering the stretch, came out further and finished with interest. CUPID'S BLING was fractious in the gate and then broke slow, angled out into the turn, chased four then five wide into the lane and was no threat. TIZ FINAL sped to the front, dictated pace from the inside, was overtaken in upper stretch then yielded in final sixteenth. VALERIA was also off bit slow, chased from the inside, came out some on the turn and never reached contention. CASH IN HAND prominently placed early, lost contact around the turn from off the rail and weakened.
