CASTAWAY sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, inched clear leaving the quarter pole and maintained the advantage to the wire under a tap of the whip and steady hand urging. BANK THE EIGHT chased off the rail and outside a rival around the turn, came into the stretch three wide, could not catch the winner but gained the place in the late going. SCHERER MAGIC pressed then stalked the pace on the inside down the long backstretch, dropped back into the turn, chased inside a rival around the turn, came out for the stretch drive and was outfinished for the place. MEL'S GAME angled outside in the early going, pressed the pace three deep, then outside the winner, was asked for his best nearing the quarter pole and weakened on the inside through the final furlong.
