Footnotes

SINFULLY stalked outside, went up five wide into the turn, angled in and took the lead alongside a rival a quarter mile out, kicked clear under urging and held. SPECTACULARJOURNEY chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and gained the place. NEIL HEALY chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and went outside the pacesetter late for the show. AFFIRMED ARCH sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, kicked clear leaving the backstretch, battled briefly inside the winner leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch but just lost third. DESTINO settled inside, was in a bit tight off heels into the turn, came out slightly into the stretch and improved position. ANNUNAKI broke a bit awkwardly, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. FERNANDO SUANCINI had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, split foes a half mile out, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. COLE COLE had speed between foes then stalked between rivals or off the rail and also weakened. WARREN'S ADAM also flashed speed outside then stalked four wide to the stretch and had little left for the drive. TRIPLE FEATURE settled three deep chasing the pace, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. HEAVENLY ROAD saved ground off the pace, came out and split rivals early on the second turn, angled back in and was not a threat. DICKERY DO broke in and slowly behind the field, came off the rail early, went three deep into the turn and four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. CALIFORNIA GREY chased outside then alongside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. DENNY THE GREAT had speed between horses then stalked between foes, dropped back fast on the turn, angled in some, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
