Footnotes

SALTY EVERGREEN between rivals early, chased three wide into the bend, swung out and caught six wide entering the stretch, rallied determinedly from the far outside and was along in time. INDIAN CLASSIC settled outside, chased four then five wide into the stretch, made steady progress outside, bid between horses in deep stretch but was nailed in final strides. STRONG WIND was antsy in the gate then broke inward, was straightened away and rushed up between rivals, stalked leaders, continued three wide, moved up to grab slim lead in mid stretch, battled gamely but was collared late. PLAYFUL COUNCIL hooked up in prolonged duel outside rival, continued two wide, gained front in upper stretch, dug in gamely from the inside but gave ground grudgingly late. THEY CALL ME MR. P showed good early foot, angled over and secured the rail, remained inside into the stretch and finished evenly. LAST DIAMOND contested the pace from along the rail into and on the turn, dropped back slightly in upper stretch, fought back some then weakened approaching the finish. WINNINRULZ reserved while angling over, chased from between rivals then two wide, later came out some but was no threat. CEE'S TREASURE dropped far back in the early stages, came out in the stretch but never menaced. ONE FOR NOTHING settled early, was guided to the rail, remained along the fence thereafter and also weakened. THERE GOES DONNIE stalked from off the rail then outside rival, remained prominent while three then four wide into the stretch but gave way readily in the last eighth.
