Footnotes

DE RED CAR settled outside then alongside a rival, moved up three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid four across the track to gain the lead in midstretch and won clear under some urging and good handling late. CATATONIC CAT went up inside to press the pace then fell back some into the turn, waited off heels leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch and again in midstretch and gained the place. SMART 'N FAIR was a bit awkwardly into stride and bumped a rival lightly at the start, had good early speed and dueled three deep between foes on the backstretch, battled between horses on the turn and to midstretch and was edged for second. SLIGHT EDGE dueled four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, was between horses into the stretch and to midstretch and weakened. CAVEMAN KENO stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, split foes on the turn, went around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. POINT HAPPY bumped lightly at the break, dueled between horses on the backstretch and inside on the turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. STAUFFENBERG chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally.
