Footnotes

GIANT STEPS chased off the rail, angled in and moved up inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid three deep under some left handed urging a sixteenth out and wore down the runner-up late. IMPERIAL PRIDE angled in and tugged some while dueling for the lead along the rail, fought back in the stretch, drifted out some despite right handed urging in late stretch and could not hold off the winner. BRERETON PARK also angled in and duelled alongside the runner-up, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late but clearly bested the others. ALREADY THERE broke inward and a trifle slowly, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and did not rally. FILM FORTUNE settled alongside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. CALIFORNIA SOLDIER broke in a bit, was sent along to stalk the pace off the rail, continued alongside the winner leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
