Footnotes

WARREN'S CONCEPT stalked off the rail then inside on the turn, came out leaving the bend and three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead a sixteenth out and won clear. DEPTH broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, moved up inside leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and gained the place. ARAGORN SWORD also off a bit slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and three wide into the stretch and edged a rival for third. J J'S JAGUAR also a bit slow to begin, went between foes early then took the lead inside, inched away past the half mile pole, set the pace along the rail, was collared a sixteenth out and lost the show late. WHEELS OF JUSTICE settled just off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. FATHER PABST had speed just off the rail, dueled between horses then stalked, angled in on the turn and weakened in

the stretch. SMART HOMBRE dueled between horses then stalked between foes, continued a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. LINCECUM had good early speed and dueled four wide passing the half mile pole, stalked three deep on the turn and weakened in the stretch. NAVY SEAL SIX chased outside then three deep, dropped back and angled in some on the turn and did not rally. ROMAINE bobbed at the start, was rank and chased off the rail, lugged out and steadied on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. GOOD LITE chased outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
