ARRAIGNMENT broke a bit slowly, settled inside chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, rallied under urging between horses to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. LAMM chased between horses then outside a rival, split foes again leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied four wide in the drive and continued willingly to the wire. THE UNUSUAL ONE four wide early, stalked the leaders off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between foes in the final furlong and also went on well to the end. TE RAPA saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch then angled back in, lacked room off heels from midstretch to the sixteenth marker then got through in deep stretch.

BUD I CRUSHED IT unhurried outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. SEEKING SOLACE a bit slow to begin, settled off the pace inside, moved up into the stretch, lacked room off heels in midstretch, came out for room and could not offer the necessary late kick. CAYAMBE chased between horses then outside a rival or a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, advanced along the rail into the stretch, bid inside, took the lead past the eighth pole, inched away, came a bit off the fence in deep stretch and weakened late. TRIBAL NATION between foes on the first turn, steadied in tight into the backstretch, chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BACK AT YOU pulled his way along and angled in, dueled inside, inched away into the stretch, battled alongside a rival in midstretch, then dropped back between foes and weakened. ULTIMATE DECISION four wide on the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and also weakened. DONATO pulled his way along four wide early, angled in and dueled outside a foe, dropped back between horses in the stretch and had little left in the final furlong.
