Footnotes

CARBONITE sent between horses early, dueled a bit off the rail, jumped a shadow nearing the half mile pole, battled between foes leaving the turn, surrendered the advantage in the stretch then came back on under urging to regain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. OLIGARCH pulled his way along inside then split rivals in tight into the turn, bid along the rail leaving the turn, gained the lead, inched away in midstretch but could not hold off the winner and just saved the place. MAJOR MAGIC stalked outside a rival then three deep into the turn, continued outside a foe then just off the rail, came out into the stretch and finished willingly. LA MANO NERA angled in and stalked inside, steadied in tight into the turn to fall back, moved up again inside leaving the turn and in the stretch, came off the rail in deep stretch and bested the others. WINSOME CHARM had good early speed and dueled outside the winner then three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ROMEO ROYALE a bit slow two begin, settled outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. ERIC THE RAM hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, chased inside, came a bit off the rail leaving the turn and did not rally.
