Footnotes

IOTAPA stalked three deep to the stretch, bid three wide under an aggressive hand ride in the drive, gained the lead while drifting out a sixteenth from home and inched away under a long hold late. DIVAS AND DIAMONDS broke in and bobbled slightly, dueled outside a rival, put a head in front between horses into the stretch, fought back in the final furlong and just held second. PAT'S BACK pulled her way along to stalk between foes, waited off heels leaving the turn, came out then angled in some in the stretch, found room around a rival past midstretch and just missed the place. PURSUITOFFPARADISE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back past midstretch and weakened late. TANGLED ROCK saved ground chasing the pace throughout and weakened in the drive. HALF MOON GAMBLER hesitated to be away slowly, was sent along outside a rival then chased off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. BELLISIME angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
