Footnotes

FIRE IN THE WIND had speed four wide then stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch to gain the lead and gamely prevailed under urging. DAVE'S PACEMAKER angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch, split horses just past the eighth pole, bid inside the winner and continued willingly to the wire. ADAM SUANCES unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished well to clearly best the others. LONE JUSTICE had good early speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, was between foes again into the stretch and weakened. CAHILL REPORT was sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. CLASSICAL SLEW had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, angled in some into the turn, continued outside the runner-up on the bend and had little left for the stretch.
