Footnotes

OCTANE sent inside then saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up three deep late. LAKERVILLE stalked the pace outside, bid three deep on the turn and in the stretch, briefly put a head in front between horses late but could not hold off the winner. A TOE BY THREE had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses leaving the turn and in the stretch, gained a slim advantage in midstretch, fought back to the wire and continued willingly. LEAD BLOCKER pulled between horses and steadied early to drop back, continued to tug his way along off the rail or outside a rival on the backstretch, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished with interest. BOOMPA angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and through the stretch and was outfinished. SABOR AMARGO (CHI) stalked outside a rival then between foes into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. BRACE YOURSELVES had good early speed and dueled inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back in the drive but weakened late.
