CAPITAL PLAN stalked outside a rival, advanced three deep on the backstretch, bid alongside QUAINLY a half mile out, battled alongside that one on the second turn and through the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch and held on gamely under urging between rivals late. CAMBINA (IRE) settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, continued three wide on that turn and into the stretch and finished willingly. QUAINLY tugged her way to the lead a bit off the rail in the chute, set the pace inside, inched away briefly leaving the first turn, battled along the fence into and on the second turn and in the stretch, came a bit off the inside in deep stretch and continued gamely to the end. IMPERIALISTIC DIVA (IRE) angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, lacked room off heels nearing midstretch until the sixteenth pole, angled in again and finished with interest inside the top three. CAMILLE C pressed the pace outside the runner-up, stalked leaving the first turn then between foes on the backstretch and second turn and weakened some late. SLANE CASTLE settled a bit off the rail, came out into the backstretch, moved up four wide on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back and angled in leaving that turn and weakened.
