Footnotes

FULL'S FIGUREHEAD bobbled a bit at the start, pulled her way between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, opened up leaving the backstretch, drifted out and in a bit from the whip in the stretch and held sway. BRITENESS had good early speed and stalked off the rail to the stretch and just held second. IT'S AINE chased between horses then three deep into the turn, continued outside a rival on the bend and a bit wide into the stretch and was edged for the second. GLORYANDPRAYER settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, split horses into the turn and weakened in the stretch. WARREN'S MO MONEY sent inside ot stalk the pace, saved ground on the turn, dropped back in the stretch and also weakened. LIGHT OF LIFE chased the pace three deep on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, dropped back off the inside, gave way while a bit erratic in the stretch and was eased late.
