ABOVE PAR chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to be along in time. RUN'N ON RESIDUALS hopped a bit at the start, had speed between horses then dueled alongside a rival, inched away and angled to the inside into the stretch, kicked clear and was caught late. HIDDEN QUEST had speed three deep then stalked off the rail, angled in alongside a rival into the stretch and bested the others. CLOCKER MOMENT dropped back between foes early, was allowed to settle off the inside chasing the pace, continued alongside a rival on the turn and did not rally. SUPERCHUPACABRA saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. TIZ A PHANTOM broke slowly and steadied, settled off the inside, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. SWISS GAME was sent between horses then dueled inside, battled along the rail on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
