Footnotes

YANKEE DAN sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, inched away into the stretch and won clear under urging. SKIP TONY stalked the winner just off the rail, bid alongside that one on the second turn, could not match strides in the stretch but clearly bested the others. TAKE NO PRISONERS washed out at the gate, pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, continued just off the fence on the second turn and held third. DEAL' EM angled in outside a rival then steadied off heels early on the first turn, chased alongside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. NOBLE KENT four wide early then three deep on the first turn, angled in outside a rival, chased a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. JUAN'S TWIN pulled early and was in a bit tight off heels into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, went around a rival into the stretch then lacked a rally inside in the drive. SUPER CANDY broke slowly, angled in alongside a rival nearing the first turn, chased outside a foe on the backstretch, found the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat. RUDE BOBBY saved ground off the pace, came out a bit leaving the second turn and into the stretch and failed to menace.
