Footnotes

WARRENS WILD THING saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and wore down the runner-up under urging in deep stretch. SARANGANI had speed outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, remained clear on the second turn and until past midstretch but could not hold off the winner. ROYAL MERIDIAN between rivals early, chased outside a foe, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held third. TIZPAT settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for the show. GALITZIANER chased three deep on the first turn and into the backstretch, continued off the rail nearing the second turn, angled in leaving that turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. TRAWEEK saved ground stalking the leader, continued between foes into and out of the second turn and weakened. ZUBOFF chased inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch and three deep into the second turn, dropped back on that bend and had little left for the stretch.
