Footnotes

SANTA LUCIA broke a bit slowly, chased off the rail or outside a rival, bid six wide leaving the turn, bumped with the runner-up five wide into the stretch, gained the lead, drifted in some and gamely prevailed under some urging. YODELMESOMEMAGIC dueled inside then fell back some into the turn and stalked along the rail, came out on the turn, bid five wide leaving the turn, bumped with the winner four wide into the stretch, also drifted in, fought back off the rail through the final furlong and went on gamely to the end. EDDIES CURL broke in and behind the field, saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted out then in from the whip in the drive but finished well. WATER ISSUES dropped back outside then settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn, swung out into the stretch and also finished with interest. SHE'S FLUSH dueled five wide then four wide into and on the turn, battled three deep between foes into the stretch and weakened. DIVINE WAY had good early speed and dueled between horses to the stretch and also weakened. MONSTRO NESS vied for command between horses then inside into and on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. TIME FOR A MEMORY dueled between rivals, fought back on the turn, was squeezed back into the stretch and had little left for the drive. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the former initiated the contact.
