Footnotes

CHICSDIGTHESHARK broke on top and quickly sped to the lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and into the stretch, drifted out in the drive but held on gamely under urging. SIR ALLISON stalked the winner outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn, bid alongside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly between foes late. MAGIC BEAM chased outside a rival then off the inside, came out into the stretch and finished with good energy alongside the top pair late. TIZ DYNAMIC chased off the rail then inside, inched forward early on the turn then was momentarily in a bit close off heels past the three eighths pole, came out for room, split horses into the stretch, continued between foes in midstretch and lacked a further response. DOMONATION a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. ROYAL DREAM stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back and angled in on the turn and weakened.
