YOU CAN DREAM stalked outside then three deep, bid three wide leaving the turn, took a short lead, battled between foes in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. EASY GOES BY stalked between foes then three deep leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch, bid five wide in midstretch and continued willingly outside the winner to the wire. THIS MEANS WAR broke inward and a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, inched forward into the stretch, got through in close quarters with a bid along the rail in midstretch, could not match the top pair late but edged rivals for the show. CARRIE ROSE was in a good position stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, came out under urging in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out and was edged for third. MARY CONTRARY pulled a bit then stalked inside or a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the turn and in the stretch and weakened late. LUCKYVIC close up tracking the pace between horses, fell back leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ROAR BABY ROAR sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back leaving the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between foes in midstretch, then weakened.
