OAK KYE WHY had good early speed and set the pace along the inside on a clear advantage, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held gamely under some late urging. FEAR THE BEARD chased a bit off the rail then inside, cut the corner into the stretch, remained along the fence in the drive and edged a rival for the place. ACHILLES a bit slow to begin, angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes to the stretch, continued alongside the runner-up in the drive and was edged for second. SLAMMER TIME saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and bested the others. BI TOMORROW angled in and stalked off the rail, went three deep into the stretch and weakened. UNUSUAL JAZZ a bit slow to begin, pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch and four wide into the second turn, continued three wide into the stretch and did not rally. DEACON SPEAKIN' a bit fractious in the gate, angled in then came out into the backstretch, chased off the rail or outside, went three wide on the second

turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BUFFALO BILLY (IRE) dwelt to be away behind the field, settled a bit off the rail and was outrun. PASSING GAME stalked off the rail, dropped back between horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and gave way.
