PINK BLOSSOM sped to the lead from between horses then angled in, set the pace on a clear advantage along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. SELLERIA was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came off the rail for room in midstretch and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. GELILA three deep early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep into and out of the second turn and also finished with interest for the show. TWITCH sent inside early, saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail into the second turn, continued alongside the runner-up leaving that turn and in midstretch and could not summon the necessary late response. AMULAY angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WILLETTA three wide into the first turn, chased off the rail then a bit off the fence into the second turn, came out a bit wide into the lane and lacked the needed rally. BONITA SONADOR chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn, continued just off the inside on that turn and weakened. QUIET ADVICE fractious in the post parade, angled in early and saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a factor.
